




Recommendations




We recommend professional installation for optimal stability. The anchoring method should be chosen based on the substrate, whether brick, concrete, wood or another material. Please note that **installation is not suitable for drywall.**

A chemical anchor may be suitable for certain surfaces to ensure a secure fit. Always consider the specific characteristics of the installation surface when choosing the mounting technique.




The large bar must not be inserted into the lower circular section of the Wallbar. It is designed to be used only with the main, upper part.

Improper use of the large bar in the lower section can cause damage to the construction and lead to potential injury. Please ensure correct placement before use.




Positioning range


Lowest mounting position




Highest mounting position




Dimensions for bracket mounting











Assess the Wall Material

Determine the type of wall material (brick, concrete, wood,...) to choose the appropriate anchoring method.

Select Anchoring Method

Based on the wall material, select the proper anchoring system. In some cases, a chemical anchor may be required for added stability.

Professional Installation Recommended


For best results and secure installation, it is highly recommended to consult a professional installer.

Follow the manufacturer's instructions for drilling and securing the anchors into the wall substrate.





Demonstration of installation using a chemical anchor





The frame has multiple mounting positions for attaching to the wall. If needed, additional mounting positions can be used to ensure a more secure installation.



Marked default position - choose from multiple positions for optimal setting.


